The decision to close the school is a complex one, weighing up many factors including the safety and heating on the site, the conditions of the roads/pavements in the close vicinity to the school, and the ability of staff and children to travel to school without undue risk to their well-being. The Chair of Governors and Headteacher then make their decision.
